OTHERWORLDLY A SHADOWED AWAKENING JBC: WHAT IS YOUR 15-SECOND ELEVATOR PITCH FOR A SHADOWED AWAKENING?

AL: A Shadowed Awakening is about a woman reincarnated in a fantasy world (as one is) but she is NOT happy to be there. She had a great life in the before and now she's been reborn in the worst way possible---as an eight year old! It heavily features shadow and crafting magic, as well as magic as a coping mechanism.

JBC: HOW DO YOU WRITE CHARACTERS WHO ARE "PLAYERS" VERSUS "NPCS"?

AL: Well, technically I don't! In my book everyone has access to the same leveling system. Thus, it's more in depth when creating a character. Though, typically the main characters and side characters have more interesting Classes and Skills than everyone else!

JCB: LITRPG BLENDS NARRATIVE STORYTELLING WITH TECHNICAL, ALMOST RULE-BASED ELEMENTS. HOW DOES THAT IMPACT YOUR WRITING PROCESS COMPARED TO TRADITIONAL FANTASY OR SCI-FI?

AL: Socoocoo many spreadsheets. Experience, levels, attributes, they all have to be accounted for in a fight---and a conversation. It's a lot more work on the back end to be honest. Otherwise, it's similar to any other hard magic system. All magic has its limits.
